**Appointment Instructions****Patient Instructions**

Visit Type: PET EYES TO MID THIGHS

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION** for PET/CT Scan: NOT following these instructions will result in rescheduling the test to another date.

1. DO NOT eat or drink anything for 6 hours before your test- except for water (you may have as much plain water as you want). This includes no gum, mints, or hard candy. You can take all medications as normally scheduled.
2. PLEASE ARRIVE 30 minutes before your scheduled exam time. The dose ordered is time specific and can only be used for your appointment. If you are late the material will not be usable for your scan and you will have to be rescheduled.
3. NO EXERCISE OR PHYSICAL THERAPY for 24 hours prior to your exam as it can increase muscle uptake on your exam.
4. WEAR COMFORTABLE AND WARM CLOTHING. Staying warm can help improve image quality. • Avoid wearing metal buttons, zippers, and jewelry if possible. All metal will have to be removed prior to imaging.
5. CLAUSTROPHOBIC patients or tend to be extremely nervous, consult your doctor about a prescription bring your medication with your for your exam.

6. BLOOD SUGAR LEVELS (Below 200 mg/dL)- will be checked prior to the start of the procedure for all patients. If you are taking predisone or steroid medication, this may have to be held 6 hours prior to the procedure because these can raise sugar levels.

7. FEEDING TUBE- PLEASE stop all tube feedings at least 8-10 hours prior to your scan. We understand that not all patients can do this. If you have concerns please call 757-213-5791.

8. FEMALE PATIENTS BETWEEN AGE 10-55 years old-LMP (Last start date of menstrual cycle) will be asked and documents. All patient with a LMP greater than 28 days who have not been surgically sterile will be required to obtain a blood serum pregnancy test 48-72 hours prior to date of PET scan. Results must be available. Menopausal women are those who can document LMP greater than 1 year confirmed by ordering MD.

DIABETIC PREP - Please be sure to follow all of the above instructions. DO NOT TAKE diabetic medications 6 hours prior to your test; (insulin, glucophage, metformin, etc.) We will check your blood glucose level and any reading over 200 will result in the scan being rescheduled.
