You may check-in up to 5 days before your appointment through eCheck-in on MyChart. It will save you time with your onsite registration.

Please arrive 5 minutes before your appointment. If you arrive more than 5 minutes in advance, please wait in your vehicle until it is time to come into the clinic.

Additionally you may receive an email from the state's Vaccine Management System (nccvms@dhhs.nc.gov) for you to register and complete a health questionnaire. Please follow the instructions in that email as soon as you receive it.

Vaccination appointments will take about an hour. You need to bring a photo ID to your appointment. If you have an insurance card, please bring it with you.

Masks are required at our clinics. Don't forget your mask, or we will provide one for you. We currently have visitor restrictions for your safety, so you may only bring one person with you to your appointment, if needed.

When you arrive, you will go through our health screening process. You will check in and review basic education about the vaccine with our team members. Then you will receive your vaccination.

After you receive your vaccine, you will wait about 15 minutes so we can ensure you are feeling well. It's possible that you will experience mild side effects for up to 48 hours after receiving the vaccine.

If your vaccine requires two doses, you will be given information about when to come back for a second dose and asked to make a follow-up appointment. You will also be given a card with information about which vaccine you received and the date of the first dose. Please keep this card and bring it with you to your follow-up appointment. If you have a mobile device with a camera, we encourage you to take a photo of this card as well.

If you would like to reschedule your appointment for a later date, you can cancel your appointment through MyChart. Or, call the Duke COVID-19 Hotline: 919-385-0429. The hotline is open every day from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.

sign up for MyChart, we will verify your identity using questions from a third-party system.
