IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Continued Assistance Act increased the maximum amount of benefits available under the PEUC program from 13 weeks to 24 weeks.

The additional PEUC benefits authorized by the Continued Assistance Act may only be collected for weeks ending on or after December 27, 2020.

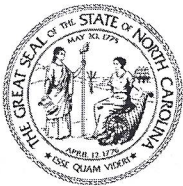
The PEUC program expires March 14, 2021. However, you may be eligible for a phaseout period to receive PEUC through no later than the week ending April 10, 2021, if you are eligible to resume filing your claim for PEUC, receive a PEUC payment for week ending March 13, 2021, and you have remaining entitlement on your claim.

REDETERMINATION RIGHTS: The PEUC weekly benefit amount is equal to your state unemployment claim weekly benefit. If you disagree with this determination, you may request a correction within (10) days from the mail date on this notice. You will speak with an experienced counselor and develop a personalized reemployment strategy using a variety of services available through NCWorks. The program is provided at no cost to you. You may be eligible for additional training services, available at no cost to you. You will need to have your Social Security Card to participate.

3. Have a copy of your work experience or resume with you to discuss during your appointment.
